The PTO is very involved in many different activities at LeTort and are essential to what we do every single day. **Please make sure to like us on Facebook!**

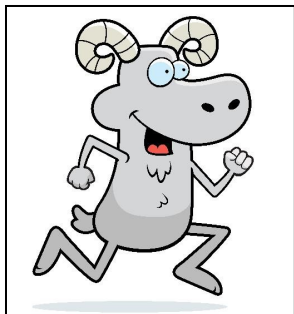

State law requires a written explanation from the parent/guardian each time a child is absent from school. Please remember to send a written excuse when your child returns to school after an absence.

To assure proper attendance recording, if your child is going to be late, or will be leaving early, he/she MUST be signed in/out at the office.

The Carlisle School District will grant up to 5 days of prearranged absence per school year. Please be sure to notify the office when you plan to use a prearranged absence so that we can get you the paperwork to complete.

Students are expected to be in their classroom by the 8:40 tardy bell. Excessive tardiness will result in a letter to parents or a phone call. Accumulated tardy minutes are totaled and count toward an illegal absence.

- **LeTort Elementary School** encourages parents to volunteer, participate in their child's class, and to observe classroom activities.
- **LeTort Elementary School** provides parents access to a parent resource center, on-line resources, and access to organizations in the community.
- **LeTort Elementary School** encourages parents to attend all Title I family events.
