I am thrilled to welcome you to the 2019-2020 school year at LeTort Elementary School! The faculty and staff are busy preparing the school and classrooms for another exciting year of learning and growth. I am looking forward to hearing about your summer adventures, catching up with returning families, and meeting our incoming families. Below you will find detailed information about our arrival and dismissal process:

8:25- Doors open and students will go to their classrooms. **Please do not send your child earlier than 8:25.**

8:25-8:45- Optional breakfast in the classroom will be served. All students will be completing academic work during this time.

8:40- Late bell rings

In the morning (Arrival):

4th and 5th grade students should enter through the Bedford Street entrance. This parking lot will be closed during arrival times.

Kindergarten-3rd grade students should enter through the South Street entrance.

During the school day:

All visitors and late arrivals should enter through the Bedford Street entrance. Visitors should use this parking lot to park. Please always bring your state ID with you when you come to the building.

End of the school day (Dismissal):

3:25- 4th and 5th grade walkers will be dismissed through the Bedford Street entrance. The Parking lot will be closed during dismissal times.

3:25- Kindergarten students will be dismissed out the doors adjacent to their classrooms.

3:25- 2nd and 3rd grade walkers will be dismissed through the South Street entrance.

3:27- 1st grade students will be dismissed through the South Street entrance.

August 15th- New Student Orientation Night- 1st-5th grade @ 5:30

August 15th- Back to School Night- 1st -5th grade @ 6:30
